UniAdca TS22 complete stainless steel, maintenance free sealed series thermostatic steam traps and air eliminators are specifically designed for use on process equipment such as kettle cookers, sterilizers, food, chemical and laundry equipment.

These traps fit the CX40 UniAdca pipeline connectors.

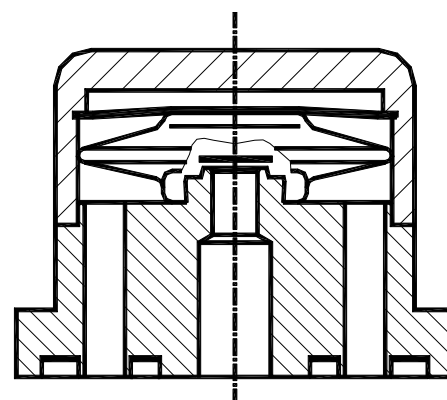

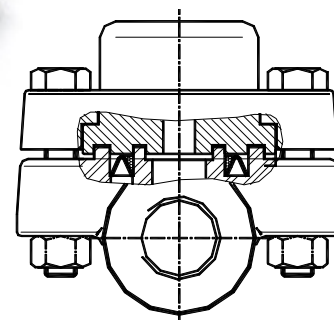
